Welcome back!

We hope you enjoyed your Easter break and are ready for the summer term in Reception. We have two Understanding the World based topics for the half terms ahead.

In summer 1, our focus is on what children enjoy learning about. We will focus on dinosaurs, space and also have a week where children think about what they would like to do when they grow up. This week we have learned about St George.

In summer 2, our learning challenge question is 'What changes can I see?' We will be learning about life cycles of mini beasts and animals that change as they grow. Children will be applying all the skills that they have learned over the year to master them and be Year 1 ready...

P.E

This term, P.E will continue be on a Friday. Please ensure that your child comes to school on this day dressed in their usual PE kit, with a waterproof coat and trainers, as all sessions will be outside. Please also ensure that earrings are removed for P.E and that your child has a water bottle, as it is important to stay hydrated throughout.

Forest Area

The Forest Area enables children to explore and discover, nurturing meaningful experiences which they will remember. Children being happy and settled is the foundation of our practice and our Forest Area contributes to this greatly.

This session will continue to be on a Wednesday. Children can come to school in appropriate old clothing, a waterproof coat and bring their wellies in a named bag.

Home Learning

This has been sent home with a Literacy & Topic and Maths activity to do. Please return on Monday 17th May. Another home learning will be sent home at the start of summer 2.

Please ensure that you read frequently with your child at home and practise their tricky words. These need to be in book bags and in school every day. Please continue to comment in your child's diary so that we know that they have read and can change their book (if they are ready to do so).

This term we will also ask for children to practise writing their surnames so that they can write both of their names confidently.
