This term we will finish off our Ancient Civilisations topic. We will then move onto our new Summer term topic: **Early Islamic Civilisations**.

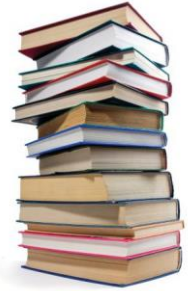
As this is the children's final term at primary school, we are looking forward making it a memorable one.
